

## **J. P World School Students Excel in KVPY, NSEC & NSEP**

Three students of J.P. World School namely Umang Bhat, Prajwal Gupta & Akarsh Sharma of Grade 12<sup>th</sup> have brought laurels for the school and Jammu & Kashmir by qualifying Kishor Vaigyanik Protsahan Yojana-2017-18(KVPY) consecutively for the second year.
